 - She presented Classroom Software usage Form
- Judy presented Sharelink 200 where students can project device on a screen. Up to 4 devices. ITS is trying to make it standard fare. ITS is working with the registrar to get into classrooms. It takes several days to upgrade the room.

- Some general discussion: Todd said ITS was asked to look at password policy. It will be extended to 6 month instead of 90 days and probably a longer password will be required.
